Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order (1) creating a non-standard, 160-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the N/2 S/2 of Section 1, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Yeso formation underlying this acreage. Said non-standard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's proposed Clydesdale 1 Fee No. 5H Well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 (Unit D) to a standard bottom hole location in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 (Unit L) of Section 1.
