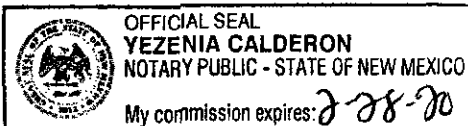

Case No. 15568 Application of COG Operating LLC for a non-standard spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order (1) creating a non-standard 240-acre, more or less, non-standard spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 W/2 of Section 10 and the E/2 NW/4 of Section 15, Township 17 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Yezo formation (Maljamar, Yezo West Pool (44500)) underlying this acreage. Said non-standard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's proposed Nelson Federal Com 13H Well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 SW/4 (Unit K) of Section 15 to a standard bottom hole location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 10. The completed interval for this well will remain within the 330-foot standard offset required by the Division's statewide rules. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of COG Operating LLC as operator of the well and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 1.5 miles South of Maljamar, New Mexico.
