#### STATEMENT OF THE CASE

#### **APPLICANT**

Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the E/2 of Section 21, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, for all pools developed on 320 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Loving Townsite 21 W2PA Fee Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a surface location 220 feet from the north line and 450 feet from the east line of adjoining Section 28, with the first take point approximately 330 feet from the south line and 450 feet from the east line of Section 21. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well-

as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
