STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Mewbourne has applied for an order (i) approving a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the E2/W2 of Section 10, Township 23 South,

Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the non-standard unit.

Marathon opposes Mewbourne's Application. The proposed well and project area are in conflict with the well and non-standard spacing unit previously proposed by Marathon (as successor-in-interest to Black Mountain Operating, LLC) in Case No. 15628, which includes the Bone Spring formation comprised of the E/2SW/4 of Section 10, Township 23 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Mewbourne objected to the application in Case No. 15628 and entered an appearance therein. Case No. 15628 was consolidated with Case Nos. 15600, 15601, 15602, 15629, and 15630, all of which were heard by the Division on March 30 and April 27, 2017, and were then taken under advisement. The Division's order on these cases remains pending.
