APPLICATION

NGL Water Solutions Permian, LLC ("NGL"), through its undersigned counsel, Montgomery and Andrews, P.A. (J. Scott Hall, Esq.), applies pursuant to 19.15.26.8 NMAC for an order authorizing the injection of water for disposal into the Silurian-Devonian Formation, Silurian-Devonian SWD pool (96101), in Lea County, New Mexico. In support of its Application, NGL states:

1. Applicant is the operator of the following well:

Striker 4 SWD No. 1
API No. 30-025-TBD
1,127' FSL & 990' FWL (Unit M)
Section 24
T-24-S, R-34-E, NMPM
Lea County, New Mexico

2. The Striker 4 SWD No. 1 well is to be drilled to a total depth of approximately 18,600'. NGL proposes to utilize the well for injection of water into the Silurian-Devonian Formation through an open hole completion from 17,100' to 18,600'.

3. Injection operations through the well will be conducted at an anticipated average daily injection pressure of 2,000 psi, and at a maximum of 3,240 psi. Applicant proposes injection of water at average daily rates of approximately 25,000 bbls and at maximum daily rates of approximately 32,500 bbls. The source of the injected fluids will be formation water from production wells that have been drilled and are scheduled to be drilled in the area.

4. Applicant's proposed injection operation can be conducted in a safe and responsible manner without causing waste, impairing correlative rights or endangering fresh water, public health or the environment.

5. Applicant's original request for administrative approval was filed with the Division on September 28, 2017. Written objection was received and consequently, the matter must be set for hearing pursuant to NMAC §19.15.26.8 D, with notice to be given by the Division.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this Application be set for hearing before a duly appointed examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on November 30, 2017 and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its Order approving the utilization of the Striker 4 SWD Well No. 1 for the injection of water into the Silurian-Devonian Formation at the intervals and at the pressures, volumes and rates indicated, and making such other and further provisions as the Division determines appropriate.

1,127 FSL & 990' FWL (Unit M)
Section 24
T-24-S, R-34-E, NMPM
Lea County, New Mexico

Applicant proposes to drill the well at the above location and utilize it for injection of produced water at depths of 17,100' to 18,600' subsurface. The well is located approximately .8 miles southeast of the intersection of State Highway 128 and County Road 2B.
