

PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT

Case No. 15914 (readvertised):

Application of Mewbourne Oil Company for a nonstandard spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order approving a 479.88 acre non-standard spacing and proration unit in the Wolfcamp formation underlying Lots 1, 2, S/2NE/4, and SE/4 (the E/2) of Section 6 and the NE/4 of Section 7, Township 24 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, and pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the non-standard spacing and proration unit. The unit will be dedicated to (i) the Pecos Valley W2AH Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a surface location in Lot 1 of Section 6, and a terminus in the SE/4NE/4 of Section 7, and (ii) the Pecos Valley W0AH Fed. Com. Well No. 2H, a horizontal well with a surface location in Lot 1 of Section 6, and a terminus the SE/4NE/4 of Section 7. The producing interval of each well will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the wells. The unit is located approximately 3-1/2 miles northeast of Malaga, New Mexico.

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
