# APPLICATION OF MANZANO, LLC FOR APPROVAL OF THE MORRISON SAN ANDRES STATE EXPLORATORY UNIT, ROOSEVELT COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

#### **APPLICATION**

Pursuant to 19.15.20.14 NMAC, Manzano, LLC ("Manzano") applies for an order approving its Morrison San Andres State Exploratory Unit ("the Unit"). In support of its application, Manzano states:

1. The proposed Unit Area for the Unit comprises 4,317.44 acres, more or less, of

State of New Mexico lands situated in Roosevelt County, described as follows:

### Township 6 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 3: All Section 4: All Section 9: N/2 NW/4, SE/4 NW/4, NE/4, and S/2 Section 10: All Section 11: S/2 N/2 and S/2 Section 14: All Section 15: All Section 16: All Section 21: N/2

2. Manzano (OGRID No. 231429) is the designated operator under the Unit Agreement.

3. The unitized interval is the San Andres formation, defined as the stratigraphic equivalent of the interval between 3,181 feet and 4,523 feet as depicted on the Laterolog dated September 12, 2014 for the Amerstrong Energy Touch of Grey State #1 well (API No. 30-041-

20960) located 1,839 feet from the south line and 417 feet from the west line in Section 15, Township 6 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., in Roosevelt County.

4. The Unit Agreement has been approved by a sufficient percentage of the interest owners within the proposed Unit Area to provide effective control of unit operations.

5. All oil and gas in the San Andres formation are unitized.

6. The entire Unit Area will be developed and operated as a single participating area.

7. Approval of this application will serve the interests of conservation, protection of correlative rights, and prevention of waste.

WHEREFORE, Manzano requests that (i) this application be set for hearing on August 9,

2018, and (ii) after notice and hearing, the Division enter an order granting this application.

The unitized interval is the San Andres formation, defined as the stratigraphic equivalent of the interval between 3,181 feet and 4,523 feet as depicted on the Laterlog dated September 12, 2014 for the Armstrong Energy Touch of Grey State #1 well (API No. 30-041-20960) located 1,839 feet from the south line and 417 feet from the west line in Section 15, Township 6 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., in Roosevelt County. The unit acreage is located approximately eight (8) miles southwest of Dora, New Mexico.

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
