APPLICATION OF MEWBOURNE OIL COMPANY FOR COMPULSORY POOLING, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

APPLICATION

Mewbourne Oil Company applies for an order pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation in a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W½W½ of Section 10, Township 23 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is an interest owner in the W½W½ of Section 10, and has the right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill the Ibex 10 B3MD Fed. Com. Well No. 1H to a depth sufficient to test the Bone Spring formation, and has dedicated the W½W½ of Section 10 to the well to form a 160 acre horizontal spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation. The well is a horizontal well, with a surface location in the NW½NW¾ of adjoining Section 15, a first take point in the SW½SW¾ of Section 10, and a final take point in the NW¼NW¼ of Section 10.
- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the W½W½ of Section 10 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation in the W½W½ of Section 10, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §§70-2-17.

5. The pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the W½W½ of Section 10 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

- A. Pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the W½W½ of Section 10;
- B. Designating applicant as operator of the well;
- C. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating the cost among the well's working interest owners;
- D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and
- E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.
