

PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT

Application of Kaiser-Francis Oil Company for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Kaiser-Francis Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation in a horizontal spacing unit underlying the N/2 of Section 24, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM and the N/2 of Section 19, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to (a) the Mosaic Fed. 2419 WA Well No. 1H, with a first take point in the NW/4NW/4 of Section 24 and a final take point in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 19, (b) the Mosaic Fed. 2419 WA Well No. 2H, with a first take point in the SW/4NW/4 of Section 24 and a final take point in the SE/4NE/4 of Section 19, (c) the Mosaic Fed. 2419 WAM Well No. 1H, with a first take point in the NW/4NW/4 of Section 24 and a final take point in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 19, (d) the Mosaic Fed. 2419 WC Well No. 1H, with a first take point in the NW/4NW/4 of Section 24 and a final take point in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 19, and (e) the Mosaic Fed. 2419 WA Well No. 1H, with a first take point in the SW/4NW/4 of Section 24 and a final take point in the SE/4NE/4 of Section 19. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the wells. The unit is located 4 miles southwest of Malaga, New Mexico.

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
