ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing to the Division that Order No. R-20310, issued in Case No. 16216 which was heard on June 28, 2018, and on July 12, 2018, and dated January 11, 2019, does not correctly state the intended order of the Division. This is issued *nunc pro tunc* to correct Order No. R-20310.

NOW, on this 1st day of February, 2019, the Division Director,

FINDS THAT

(1) The Division incorrectly described the well name and bottom-hole location for the well referenced in Finding Paragraph (5) and Ordering Paragraph (9) and should be corrected as follows.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT

(1) Finding Paragraph (5) is hereby amended to read as follows:

(5) The Unit will be dedicated to the following Well(s):

Gaucha 21 Federal Well No. 6H; API No. 30-025-Pending

SHL: 175 feet from the South line and 185 feet from the East line,
Unit P of Section 21, Township 22 South, Range 34 East, NMPM.

BHL: 330 feet from the North line and 380 feet from the East line,
Unit A of Section 21, Township 22 South, Range 34 East, NMPM.

(2) Ordering Paragraph (3) is hereby amended to read as follows:

(3) The Unit will be dedicated to the following Well(s):

Gaucha 21 Federal Well No. 6H; API No. 30-025-Pending

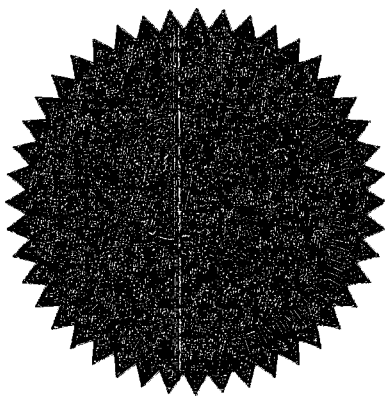
SHL: 175 feet from the South line and 185 feet from the East line,
Unit P of Section 21, Township 22 South, Range 34 East, NMPM.

BHL: 330 feet from the North line and 380 feet from the East line,
Unit A of Section 21, Township 22 South, Range 34 East, NMPM.

(3) The corrections set forth in this order be entered nunc pro tunc as of January 11, 2019.

(4) In all other respects, Division Order No R-20310 shall remain in full force and effect as originally written.
