APPLICATION OF MEWBOURNE OIL COMPANY FOR COMPULSORY POOLING, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

APPLICATION

Mewbourne Oil Company applies for an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying a 640-acre horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 of Section 11 and the N/2 of Section 12, Township 23 South, Range 26 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is an interest owner in the N/2 of Section 11 and the N/2 of Section 12, and has the right to drill a well or wells thereon.
- Applicant proposes to drill the following wells to a depth sufficient to test the
 Wolfcamp formation (Purple Sage-Wolfcamp Gas Pool):
 - (a) The Wingman 12/11 W0AD Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, with a first take point in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 12 and final take point in the NW/4NW/4 of Section 11; and
 - (b) The Wingman 12/11 W0HE Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, with a first take point in the SE/4NE/4 of Section 12 and final take point in the SW/4NW/4 of Section 11.
- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the N/2 of Section 11 and the N/2 of Section 12 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests.

Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the N/2 of Section 11 and the N/2 of Section 12, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §70-2-17.

5. The pooling of all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the N/2 of Section 11 and the N/2 of Section 12 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

- A. Pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the N/2 of Section 11 and the N/2 of Section 12;
- B. Designating applicant as operator of the wells;
- C. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the wells, and allocating the cost among the wells' working interest owners;
- D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and
- E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the wells in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the wells.
