STATEMENT OF THE CASE

COG's application seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation in a 160-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W/2 E/2 of Section 18, Township 24 South, Range 34 East in Lea County, New Mexico. The horizontal spacing unit will be dedicated to the Sebastian Federal Com #704H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Unit B to a bottom hole location in Unit O in Section 18, Township 24 South, Range 34 East. The completed interval for the well will be orthodox.


