Dear Sir:

Reference is made to your request of May 20, 1986 to increase the surface injection pressure on your N. Vacuum Abo East Unit Wells Nos. 1 & 9. This request is based on a step rate tests conducted on the wells during April, 1986. The results of the tests have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on these wells is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase your surface injection pressure on the following wells:

Well & Location Surface Pressure

N. Vacuum Abo Unit No. 1 2300 PSIG Unit J. Section 7, T-17S, R-35E

N. Vacuum Abo Unit No. 9 2300 PSIG Unit J, Section 18, T-17S, R-35E

Both in Lea County, New Mexico

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or it is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
