Dear Mr. Maxey:

Reference is made to your request dated July 31, 1991, to increase the surface injection pressure on two wells within the Bunkerhill Unit Waterflood Project. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on one of these wells on May 30, 1991. The results of the test have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on these wells is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following wells.

Bunkerhill Unit Well No. 15 Unit P, Section 14, T-16S, R-31E, NMPM	1450 PSIG
Bunkerhill Unit Well No. 19 Unit D, Section 24, T-16S, R-31E, NMPM	1450 PSIG
Both in Eddy County	

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
