Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests to the Pictured Cliffs formation and the Basin Fruitland Coal-Gas Pool underlying both the NW/4, the SW/4 and the W/2 of Section 7, T29N, R14W, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any production from the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool and forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any production from the Pictured Cliffs formation, including but not limited to the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool. These units are to be dedicated to its WF Ropco "7" Well No. 2 (API# 30-045-33190) to be drilled at a standard gas well location in Unit C of this section and to its WF Ropco "7" Well No. 3 (API# 30-045-33416) to be drilled at a standard gas well location in Unit M of this section both to be downhole commingled production from the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool and the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool. Also to be considered will be the costs of drilling and completion of this well and the allocation of the costs thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Lance Oil & Gas Company, Inc. as the operator of the well and a 200% charge for risk involved in this well. 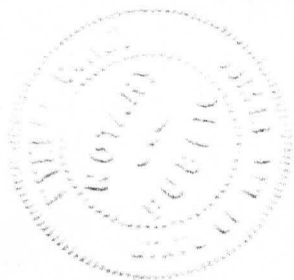
