Dear Mr. Catanach:

Further to Mr. Bruce's June 29, 2006, letter to you describing Joseph Robbins' interest as a mineral interest, we have located the attached Warranty Deed Record No. 87 from Mr. Robbins' great aunt, Martha Blitzkie, to Franklin Lanier (predecessor in interest to the Smiths) of one-half of her interest in the subject property. Mrs. Blitzkie reserves "a royalty of one-sixteenth (1/16) of all oil/or/and gas produced from said described real estate..." This reserved royalty interest passed through devise and descent to Joseph Robbins. 1/16 of 1/2 is 1/32 of the whole. 1/32 is 3.125%. This indicates Mr. Robbins' 3.125% interest is a royalty interest. Mr. Robbins owned no working interest to Farmout to Synergy. Thus, aside from Mr. Robbins' timely rescission of that Farm-out, Synergy cannot rely on a royalty interest to support an application to drill.
