APPLICATION

Roca Operating, Inc. applies for an order pooling all mineral interests from the top of the Wolfcamp formation to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the N% of Section 36, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is operator the NM 36 State Com. Well No. 1, located in the NW½NE½ of Section 36, and has completed the well in the Morrow formation. Applicant seeks to dedicate the N½ of Section 36 to the well to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the North Quail Ridge-Morrow Gas Pool.
- 2. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the N% of Section 36 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 3. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the N½ of Section 36, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §70-2-17.

4. The pooling of all mineral interests underlying the N½ of Section 36, as set forth above, will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

- A. Pooling all mineral interests in the N½ of Section 36 from the top of the Wolfcamp formation to the base of the Morrow formation; and
- B. Designating applicant as operator of the well.
