APPLICATION

Arch Petroleum Inc. applies for an order granting an exception to Division Rule 303.A, and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant is the operator of the fee leases and lands described below:

2. Applicant proposes to commingle Teague Paddock-Blinebry Pool production from the nine wells described below into the existing tank battery for the E.C. Hill "C" Well No. 3, located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, without separately metering production, by allocating production to each well and to each lease on the basis of monthly well tests:


