Application of Samson Resources Company for Compulsory Pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying Lots 9, 10, 15, 16, and the SE/4 of Section 4, Township 16 South, Range 27 East, to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including but not limited to the Undesignated Diamond Mound-Wolfcamp Gas Pool, Undesignated Diamond Mound-Atoka Gas Pool, and Undesignated Diamond Mound-Morrow Gas Pool. The unit will be dedicated to applicant's Banshee "4" Fed. Com. Well No. 1, to be drilled at an orthodox location in Lot 16 (Unit P) of Section 4. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The unit is located approximately 10 miles northeast of Artesia, New Mexico.

Amended Application of V-F Petroleum Inc. for Compulsory Pooling and an Unorthodox Surface Location, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in all formations developed on 320-acre spacing from a depth of 3,500 feet (the approximate base of the San Andres formation) to the base of the Morrow formation (approximate depth of 11,152 feet) underlying the N/2 of Section 34, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, forming a standard gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools spaced on 320 acres within said vertical extent, which presently includes but is not necessarily limited to the Undesignated North Turkey Track-Morrow Gas Pool.. Said pooled unit is to be dedicated to its Samuel Burns "34" State Well No. 3 located at an unorthodox surface location 450 feet from the North line and 2,100 feet from the East line (Unit B) of said Section 34 that applicant proposes to re-enter and directionally drill to a standard location in the Morrow formation in the NW/4 NE/4 of the section. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 14 miles southeast of Artesia, New Mexico.
