WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 8:55 a.m.:

EXAMINER STOGNER: At this time I'll call Case

Number 13,122, which is the Application of Yates Petroleum

At this time I'll call for appearances.

Corporation for approval of a Unit Agreement, Lea County,

New Mexico.

MR. FELDEWERT: May it please the Examiner,
Michael Feldewert with the Santa Fe office of Holland and
Hart, appearing on behalf of Yates Petroleum Corporation
today.

EXAMINER STOGNER: Any other appearances?

Mr. Feldewert, you may continue.

MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, we are here today seeking approval of the Kris -- K-r-i-s -- State Exploratory Unit, which consists of 3200 acres of state land under which Yates proposes to test from the surface to the top of the lower Mississippian.

We are proceeding today and have provided the Division with an affidavit pursuant to the Division's new policy regrading the approval of units.

And we have marked as Yates Exhibit Number 1 an affidavit that is signed by Mr. John Amiet, who is a petroleum geologist with Yates Petroleum Corporation. He has attached to his affidavit -- Well, first of all, within

his affidavit he discusses what they propose to do in this unit area.

And then he has attached to his affidavit as Exhibit A the unit agreement, which is a State Land Office form.

Exhibit B to the affidavit is a plat which identifies the unit boundary with the dark line. It basically consists of Sections 27, 28, 29, 33 and 34.

Exhibit C to the affidavit, Mr. Examiner, is then an ownership breakdown. You'll see that 100 percent of the working interest is either owned by Yates and its partners or by Murchison Oil and Gas, Inc. All of these entities have committed their interest to the unit.

And if you bear with me here, Exhibit Number 2, if you skip to that, which is towards the back of our package, it's a letter from Murchison Oil and Gas, signed by Charlene Crump in which they have committed their interests to the unit agreement.

And then what we have done with Exhibit Number 3 are the signature pages which were faxed to me last night, under which Murchison signed the unit agreement and, as well, the AFE.

Continuing on, then, with the affidavit which is marked as Exhibit Number 1, Exhibit D, as in dog, to that affidavit is the approval letter from the State of New

Mexico, giving its preliminary approval. And you should know as well, then, that 100 percent of the royalty in this unit area is State of New Mexico, and that is Exhibit D to this.

EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay, I do not have an Exhibit

D. I've got Exhibit B, which was the plat --

MR. FELDEWERT: Okay.

EXAMINER STOGNER: -- Exhibit C, which is two pages, and it lists the different things -- or, I'm sorry, the leases. And then I jump to Exhibit E as in Edward, which is a map --

MR. BROOKS: Okay, I've got Exhibit D in my package, so I'll just give my packet to you.

EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay, got that straightened out.

MR. FELDEWERT: Yeah, and I will check right after this hearing to make sure that the original with the Division also has Exhibit D.

All right. And then Exhibit E, which I hope is in your package, is a structure map, Mr. Examiner. It shows the location of the initial proposed well up in the northwest quarter of Section 28 -- it's a circle -- and it identifies the unit boundary again in red. And it's primarily offered to show the -- in blue, the projection of the sand trends in the area.

Then moving on to Exhibit F, this is a seismic 1 line which shows the initial well, the Kris State Number 1, 2 the initial proposed well. They are targeting a structural 3 low in the area. 4 This exhibit also depicts the Felmont State 5 Number 1, which was a dry hole, which indicates that it was 6 7 in a structural high that was encountered by this well. 8 So with that, Mr. Examiner, I've already identified Exhibit 2 which is the Murchison letter, and 9 then Exhibit 3 which is the -- their approval of the unit 10 11 agreement and the AFE. With that, we ask that the Division take this 12 13 matter under advisement and issue an order approving the 14 Kris State Exploratory Unit. 15 EXAMINER STOGNER: Now, Mr. Feldewert, we have proceeded with similar units in this fashion before, have 16 we not? 17 18 MR. FELDEWERT: Yes, we have, Mr. Examiner. Ι 19 know I personally did one with Mr. Jones. 20 EXAMINER STOGNER: Did that also involve Yates Petroleum? 21 22 MR. FELDEWERT: Yes, it did. 23 EXAMINER STOGNER: And at this point, at this 24 time, keeping these situated to areas in which it's 100-25 percent state or where everybody has agreed -- is that

correct? I mean, we're limiting these in scope at this 1 time; is that your understanding? 2 MR. FELDEWERT: That is my understanding. 3 recollection is that the other one in which I proceeded in 4 this fashion was -- also involved 100-percent state land, 5 6 and everyone was in agreement. EXAMINER STOGNER: Not that we can't expand that 7 later, but -- Okay. Is there any -- Do you have anything 8 9 further, Mr. Brooks? MR. BROOKS: 10 No. EXAMINER STOGNER: If there's nothing further in 11 Case 13,122, then this matter will be taken under 12 advisement. 13 14 MR.
