

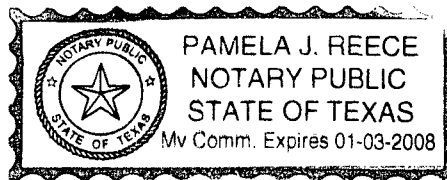

(Reopened and Readvertised): Application of Parallel Petroleum Corporation for Compulsory Pooling, Chaves County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks amendment to Order R-12780 pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Wolfcamp formation in the spacing and proration units located in the S/2 of Section 28, Township 15 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., Chaves County, New Mexico. Said unit was dedicated to Parallel's Unbridled 1525-28 Well No. 1 to be drilled at a surface location 1880 feet from the South line and 237 feet from the East line and a bottomhole location 1880 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 28, Township 15 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico to an approximate depth of 4750 feet to test any and all formations from the surface to the base of the Wolfcamp formation. Parallel seeks an order amending Order R-12780 to include certain interest owners inadvertently left out of the original pooling application. Said area is located 5 miles southwest of Lake Arthur, New Mexico.
