

Yates Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying Lots 1, 2, E/2NW/4, and NE/4 (the N/2) of Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, to form: A 321.89-acre gas spacing and proration unit for all pools or formations developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent; and a 161.89-acre gas spacing and proration unit for all pools or formations developed on 160-acre spacing.
