Ladies and Gentlemen:

This letter is to advise you that Yates Petroleum Corporation has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Wolfcamp formation in certain spacing and proration units in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 30, Township 22 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. Said pooled units are to be dedicated to Yates's Amazing BAZ Federal Well No. 3 to be drilled at a location 330 feet from the South and East lines of Section 30, Township 22 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico to an approximate depth of 8,600 feet to test any and all formations from the surface to the base of the Bone Spring formation.

This application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner at 8:15 a.m. on January 10, 2008. The hearing will be held in Porter Hall in the Oil Conservation Division's Santa Fe Offices located at 1220 South Saint Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be affected by this application, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.

Parties appearing in cases are required by Division Rule 1208.B to file a Pre-hearing Statement four days in advance of a scheduled hearing. This statement must be filed at the Division's Santa Fe office at the above specified address and should include: the names of the parties and their attorneys; a concise statement of the case; the names of all witnesses the party will call to testify at the hearing; the approximate time the party will need to present its case; and identification of any procedural matters that are to be resolved prior to the hearing.
