Docket Nos. 07-02 and 08-02 are tentatively set for March 7, 2002 and March 21, 2002. Applications for hearing must be filed at least 23 days in advance of hearing date. The following cases will be heard by an Examiner:

CASE 12822: Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an Order Authorizing the Division to Plug One (1) Well; San Juan County, New Mexico. The Applicant seeks an order authorizing the Division to plug one well and providing for such other relief as the Director deems appropriate. The affected well is the Cross, *et al*, Blackjack No. 1 located at 1013 East Cedar in Section 15, Township 29 North, Range 13 West, in the City of Farmington, San Juan County, New Mexico.

CASE 12796: Continued from February 7, 2002, Examiner Hearing.

Application of San Juan Resources, Inc. for compulsory pooling and downhole commingling, San Juan County, New Mexico. Applicant, in accordance with Division Rule 1207.A(1)(b) seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the base of the Pictured Cliffs to the top of the Dakota formations underlying the S/2 of Section 19, Township 30 North, Range 11 West, forming a standard 327.7-acre gas spacing and proration unit to be dedicated to its Kaempf Well No. 1E which is to be located at a standard gas well location within Unit I of this section for downhole commingled production from the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool and the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool. Also to be considered will be the costs of participation in this well, including but not limited to the costs of drilling, completing and equipping, with the inclusion of a risk factor penalty and the allocation of those costs and income therefore as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, and the designation of applicant as the operator of the well. This well is located approximately 2 miles east of Flora Vista, New Mexico. **IN THE ABSENCE OF OBJECTION THIS MATTER WILL BE TAKEN UNDER ADVISEMENT.**

Case No. 12811: Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an Order Requiring Operators to Bring Three Hundred Eighty-Eight (388) Wells into Compliance with Rule 201.B, and Assessing Appropriate Civil Penalties; Eddy, Chaves and Otero Counties, New Mexico. The Applicant seeks an order requiring the operators of 388 inactive wells located in Eddy, Chaves and Otero Counties, New Mexico, to bring said wells into compliance with OCD Rule 201.B by either restoring said wells to production or beneficial use, plugging and abandoning said wells or securing Division approval for temporary abandonment thereof.
