NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DRILL NEW WELL

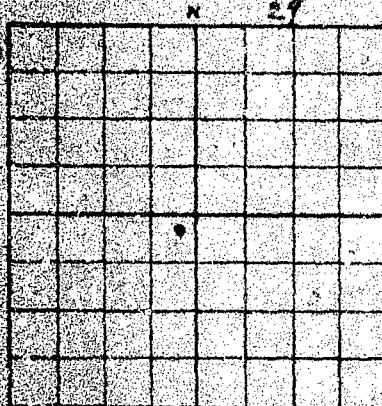

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to commence the drilling of a well to be known as Cross, Gould and Worlock Well No. three in of Sec. 15, T. 24 R. 13, east, N. M. P. M., San Juan Basin Oil Field, San Juan County County.



The well is 150 feet S. of line and 200 feet

W. of line of of Sec 15-24-13.

The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 5280 feet. We propose to drill well with No. 5 Acystone machine.

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated.

12-8 & 6	46- 28 & 18	second hand,	between 300 & 500 feet,	do not know as yet.

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 370 feet.

Additional information: This well was spudded in on the day of August 1925, and we have used 18 feet of 12 inch casing, and put in about 90 feet of 8 inch casing which has been pulled and we are now running 6 inch casing, the well at this date is 267 feet.

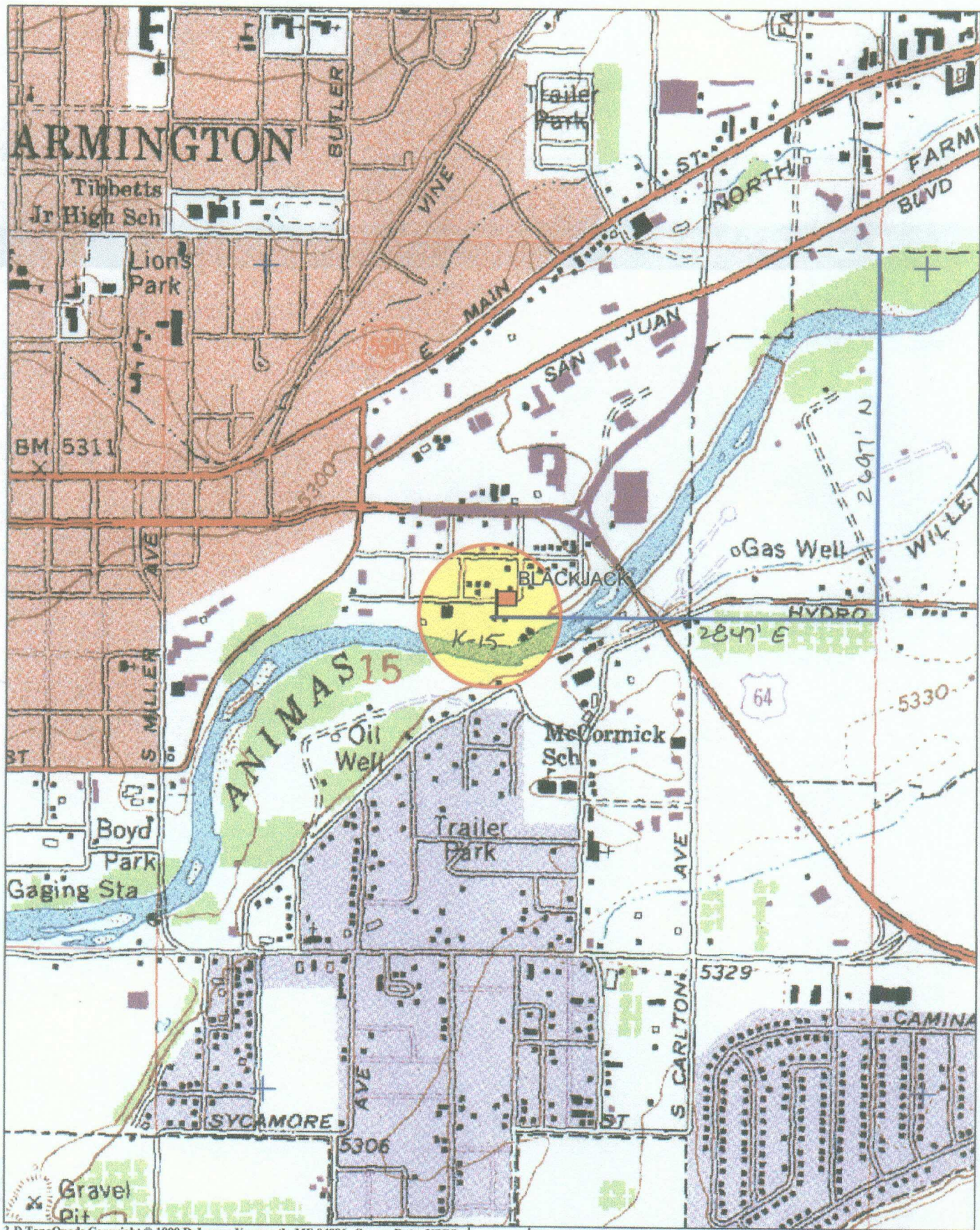
