1 MR. BROOKS: We will call Case No. 14172, Application
2 of BEPCO, LP for Compulsory Pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico.

3 Call for appearances.

4 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe,
5 representing the applicant. I meant to file an amended
6 pre-hearing statement, but I'm submitting this case by
7 affidavit.

8 MR. BROOKS: Okay. We received a letter from
9 Mr. Robert G. Shelton, and I believe that it shows that he sent
10 you a copy also.

11 MR. BRUCE: And I will address that briefly.

12 MR. BROOKS: Okay.

13 MR. BRUCE: Yes. Mr. Examiner, when this application
14 was filed, we were seeking to force-pool Mr. Shelton.
15 Mr. Shelton has joined in the well, and we are not seeking to
16 force-pool him.

17 MR. BROOKS: Okay. You may proceed.

18 MR. BRUCE: Submitted as Exhibit 1 is the verified
19 statement of Brad Glasscock, who is a landman at BEPCO. BEPCO
20 is seeking to force-pool the N/2 of Section 17, 22 South, 28
21 East. The original application said all 320-acre units, but at
22 this time, we would amend the application to seek to force-pool
23 only the Atoka and Morrow formations, and those are in the
24 Dublin Ranch-Atoka gas pool, and Dublin Ranch-Morrow gas pool.

25 The well being drilled is the Big Eddy unit well No.

1 218 to be drilled in the NW/4, NW/4 of Section 17.

2 MR. BROOKS: Big A?

3 MR. BRUCE: Big Eddy.

4 MR. BROOKS: Big Eddy. Unit number what?

5 MR. BRUCE: 218.

6 MR. BROOKS: Okay. Go ahead.

7 MR. BRUCE: The only party being force-pooled is
8 Nearburg Exploration Company, LLC, which has a working interest
9 ownership of approximately twelve and a half percent in the
10 well. Attachment A to Exhibit 1 are two land plats showing the
11 well locations. Attachment B is the proposal letter to
12 Nearburg which was mailed in May of 2008. I stated in the
13 affidavit that BEPCO has also had telephone conversations with
14 Nearburg. Nearburg has simply not yet decided what to do.

15 Attachment C is the AFE for the well. The dry hole
16 cost of this well is a little over \$2.7 million, and the
17 completed well cost is \$4.2 million. And BEPCO is seeking
18 overhead rates of 6,000 and 600 per month. Submitted as
19 Exhibit 2 is my Affidavit of Notice that showing that notice
20 was received by Nearburg of this application.

21 I move the admission of Exhibits 1 and 2 and ask that
22 the matter be taken under advisement.

23 MR. BROOKS: Exhibits 1 and 2 are admitted.

24 [Applicant's Exhibits 1 and 2 admitted into
25 evidence.]

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MR. BROOKS: You said 6,600 overhead?

MR. BRUCE: 6,000 and 600.

MR. BROOKS: All right. 6,000 for drilling and 600 for producing?

MR. BRUCE: Right.

MR. BROOKS: And I notice on the document here the location is given as 660 from the north and 660 from the west?

MR. BRUCE: Yes. And that's stated in the AFE.

MR. BROOKS: Yeah, okay. Very good. Case No. 14172 will be taken under advisement.




