Case No. 14171 \_\_\_\_\_: **Application of Samson Resources Company for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico:** Samson Resources Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the following described acreage in Section 33, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and in the following manner: The W/2 to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Undesignated South Osudo-Morrow Gas Pool; the SW/4 to form a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 160-acre spacing within that vertical extent; and the SW/4SW/4 to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Undesignated Osudo-Wolfcamp Pool. The units are to be designated to the Osudo 33 State Com. Well No. 2, to be located at an orthodox well location in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 33. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
