APPLICANT

Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the base of the Glorieta formation to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the following described acreage in Section 21, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, and in the following manner: All of Section 21 to form a standard 640-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 640-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the North Osudo-Morrow Gas Pool; the S/2 to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent; and the SW/4 to form a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 160-acre spacing within that vertical extent; and the SW/4SW/4 to form a standard d.

40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the proposed Paloma "21" State Com. Well No. 1, to be drilled at an orthodox location in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 21. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
