Confirming the May 2, 1983 telephone conversation of Larry Sheppard with Ms. Florine Davidson, Amoco Production Company (USA) respectfully requests the subject matter be docketed for the May 25, 1983 Examiner Hearing. In this application Amoco seeks approval to allow for the disposal of salt water under the provisions of Rule 701 and for an exception to Rule 104 to provide for an unorthodox location of the proposed well.


The subject well will be located 500' FNL x 565' FWL of Section 26, Township-19-North, Range-34-East. It will be utilized to dispose of water produced in association with the carbon dioxide production from the Tubb formation. This water will be disposed into the Glorieta formation.
