STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Applicant seeks an order (i) creating a new pool for production of oil from the Yates-Seven formation, to be named the West Eumont Yates-Seven Rivers Pool, comprising the NW¼ of Section 36, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M., (ii) granting applicant a discovery allowable, and (iii) establishing special rules and regulations for the pool, including a special depth bracket allowable of 350 barrels of oil per day, effective as of the date of first production from the discovery well. The discovery well for the pool is the Eumont State Well No. 1, located 900 feet from the north line and 1650 feet from the west line of Section 36.


