

This letter is to inform you of our request to the Oil Conservation Commission to amend our unorthodox location approval order #R-7220 for the Carter Estate # 1. The amendment would reflect the correct name of the producing formation, which was found to be the Yeso formation.

Our original approval order was granted for an 8100' Abo Test, however, no productive horizon was encountered at that depth, so we came up the hole to 6400' where we made a producer in the Yeso. Now it seems our original order must be amended to reflect this.
