Reference is made to Case No. 7894, in the matter of the hearing called by the Oil Conservation Division on its own motion to permit Petro-Lewis Corporation, Dyna Ray Oil and Gas Company, Inc., Floyd J. Ray and all other interested parties to appear and show cause why the Earnhardt Well No. 1 located in Unit G, Section 35, Township 24 North, Range 1 West, McKinley County, should not be plugged and abandoned in accordance with a Division-approved plugging program.
