Application of Merrion Oil and Gas, Corp. for compulsory pooling in San Juan County, New Mexico.

Merrion Oil and Gas, Corp. seeks an order pooling all unleased and uncommitted mineral interest and all uncommitted working interest owners in the Basin Fruitland Coal Pool in the N/2 of Section 18, Township 29N, Range 13W, NMPM, forming a non-standard 250 acre spacing unit for said Pool. The spacing unit will be dedicated to the drilling of the Westland Park 1 well in the NE/4 and the Westland Park 2 well in the NW/4. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing both wells and the allocation of cost thereof, as well as the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the wells. This spacing unit is located inside the city limits of Farmington, New Mexico. Upon application of Western Refining Southwest, Inc., this case will be heard De Novo pursuant to the provisions of Division Rule 19.15.4.23.
