Dear Mr. Wrangham,

The OCD Environmental Bureau has discussed this issue with Mr. Will Jones of the OCD Engineering Bureau and hereby approves of your request with the following conditions:

1. The cement shall be pumped in under pressure and once filled shall maintain a sufficient pressure to squeeze any possible leaks in the casing and be held for 30 minutes.
2. A complete plugging report shall be submitted on a C-103 with a copy provide to the district office.
3. The Santa Fe and District office shall be notified 72 hours in advance of the procedure.
4. Targa shall report any LPG product or Brine water discovered in any of the existing monitoring wells.

Please be advised that OCD approval of this plan does not relieve the owner/operator of responsibility should their operations pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment. In addition, OCD approval does not relieve the owner/operator of responsibility for compliance with any other federal, state, or local laws and/or regulations.
