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

Application of Purvis Operating Co. for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico.

Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Pennsylvanian and Devonian formations underlying the E/2NE/4 of Section 34, Township 12 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, to form a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for all pools or formations developed on 80-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Southwest Gladiola-Pennsylvanian Pool and Southwest Gladiola-Devonian Pool. The unit is to be dedicated to the Lowe Well No. 1, to be re-entered at a location 554 feet from the north and east lines (the NE/4NE/4) of Section 34. Also to be considered will be the cost of re-entering and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in re-entering and completing the well. The unit is located approximately 8 miles east-southeast of Tatum, New Mexico.

APPLICATION

Purvis Operating Co. applies for an order pooling all mineral interests in the Pennsylvanian and Devonian formations underlying the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 12 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant is an interest owner in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, and has the right to drill or re-enter a well thereon.
2. Applicant proposes to re-enter the Lowe Well No. 1, located 554 feet from the north and east lines (in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 34, to test the Pennsylvanian and Devonian formations, and seeks to dedicate the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34 to the well to form a standard 80 acre oil and spacing and proration unit for all pools or formations developed on 80-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Southwest Gladiola-Pennsylvanian Pool and Southwest Gladiola-Devonian Pool.
3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34 for the purposes set forth herein.
4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §70-2-17.

5. The pooling of all mineral interests underlying the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

- A. Pooling all mineral interests in the Pennsylvanian and Devonian formations underlying the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34;
- B. Designating applicant as operator of the well;
- C. Considering the cost of re-entering and completing the well, and allocating the cost among the well's working interest owners;
- D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and
- E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in re-entering and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.
