sensitive and aware to the fact that the Oil Conservation Commission has its own jurisdiction and rules and procedures for exercising and governing its jurisdiction over the potash/oil area, performing its statutory duties pursuant.

I'm also sensitive to the fact that this area is also subject to the jurisdiction of the Secretary of Interior and the Bureau of Land Management has its own separate and different procedures for the drilling in this area.

I'm also mindful of the fact that while I am not ready to present to you either in opposition or support of the fact that the Secretary of Interior has a potash enclave map, I am aware of the fact that that map is currently being reproduced and that the existing map that has been circulated for a number of years is in the process of being revised.

without admitting whether or not it is a necessary element of proving anyone's case or whether it's relevant to this, I'm interested in seeing what that map has to say in relation to this case.

In addition, my client has been requested by the Bureau of Land Management to cooperate with the Bureau of Land Management in allowing, subject to your judgment, Mr. Chairman, that this case be continued for some reasonable period of time so that the oil and gas operators, Bureau of Land Management, potash industry representatives, have an opportunity to look at and review the new map when
