The purpose of this letter is to notify you that on October 2, 2009 United States District Judge James Parker issued findings of fact and conclusions of law which confirm that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division does not have regulatory authority over oil and gas production on Ute Mountain Ute lands. Rather, the request sought by ConocoPhillips should be made to the Bureau of Land Management office in Durango and to the Tribe.
