In accordance with Section 10 of the Poker Lake Unit Agreement dated March 18, 1952, BOPCO, L.P., Operator of the referenced unit, hereby submits a Plan of Development for the Poker Lake Unit for the year 2010.

HISTORY OF PAST DEVELOPMENT

We refer to our previous Plans of Development for a detailed description of the operations conducted in this Unit in prior years.

2009 ACTIVITY

<u>Poker Lake Unit Well No. 199, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> – This was drilled at a legal location being 1,000' FSL & 1,685' FWL, Section 28, T24S-R31E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This well was completed in the Morrow Formation as a gas well.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Well No. 265H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> – This was drilled at a legal location being 660' FSL & 660' FWL, Section 6, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This well was completed in the Bone Springs Formation as an oil well.

<u>Poker Lake Unit No. 300-H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This well was drilled at a legal location being 600' FSL & 2,200' FWL, Section 27, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This well was completed in the Delaware Formation as an oil well.

<u>Poker Lake Unit No. 301H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This was drilled at a legal location being 2,310' FNL, 2,460' FNL Section 27, T24S-R31E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This well was completed in the Delaware Formation as an oil well.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Ross Ranch 31 Federal #1H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This was drilled at a legal location being 350' FSL & 2290' FEL, Section 31, T25S-R31E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This well was completed in the Bone Spring Formation as an oil well.

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<u>Poker Lake Unit Ross Ranch 6 Federal #1H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This was drilled at a legal location being 350' FSL & 350' FEL, Section 6, T26S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This well was completed in the Bone Spring Formation as an oil well.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Pierce Canyon 32 State #1H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This was drilled at a legal location being 350' FSL & 350' FEL, Section 32, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This well was completed in the Bone Spring Formation as an oil well.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Pierce Canyon 28 Federal #1H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This was drilled at a legal location being 350' FNL & 850' FEL Section 28, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This well was completed in the Bone Spring Formation as an oil well.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Big Sinks 26 Federal #1H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This was drilled at a legal location being 150' FSL, 600' FWL Section 26, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This well was completed in the Bone Spring Formation as an oil well.

2009 PLUGGED AND ABANDONED

No Poker Lake Unit wells were plugged and abandoned in 2009.

PARTICIPATING AREAS

The above Delaware wells are included in the proposed Fourth Revision to the Delaware C Participating Area which has been approved by the BLM and other agencies.

Bass has submitted Commercial Determinations for all productive wells for which same have not been prepared in the past and will submit wells drilled to date where adequate information is available for commercial determination and participating areas. In the event you have not received commercial determination for the wells that have been drilled and completed and are currently producing, please advise at your convenience and we will submit same to you.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENT

<u>Poker Lake Unit Well No. 293 1H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> – This well will be drilled at a legal location being 810' FNL & 1,980' FEL, Section 21, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 13,600' to test the Delaware Formation.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Well No. 293 2H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> – This well will be drilled at a legal location being 810' FNL & 1,980' FEL & 1,980', Section 21, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 13,300' to test the Delaware Formation.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Well No. 302 H.</u> Eddy County, New Mexico – This well will be drilled at a legal location being 1,854' FEL & 2,300' FNL, Section 28, T24S-R31E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 13,907' to test the Devonian Formation.

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<u>Poker Lake Unit Well No. 303H</u>, <u>Eddy County</u>, <u>New Mexico</u> – This well will be drilled at a legal location being 1,264' FSL & 2,310' FWL, Section 4, T25S-R31E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 14,165' to test the Delaware Formation.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Well No. 308H</u>, <u>Eddy County</u>, <u>New Mexico</u> – This well will be drilled at a legal location being 2,300' FNL & 330' FEL, Section 26, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 13,500' to test the Delaware Formation.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Well No. 311</u>, <u>Eddy County</u>, <u>New Mexico</u> – This well will be drilled at a legal location being 1,005' FSL & 1,693' FWL, Section 2, T25S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 13,500' to test the Wolfcamp Formation.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Pierce Canyon 5 State #1H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This will be drilled at a legal location being 350' FSL & 350' FEL, Section 5, T25S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 13,590' to test the Bone Spring Formation.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Pierce Canyon 12 Federal #1H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This will be drilled at a legal location being 250' FSL, 217 FEL Section 12, T24S-R29E, Eddy County, New Mexico Mexico to a proposed depth of 12,921' to test the Bone Spring Formation.

Poker Lake Unit Phantom Banks 1 Federal #1H, Eddy County, New Mexico - This will be drilled at a legal location being 400' FSL, 1,980 FEL Section 1, T26S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 12,797' to test the Bone Spring Formation.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Big Sinks 22 Federal #1H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This will be drilled at a legal location being 100' FSL, 400' FEL Section 22, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 8,125' to test the Bone Spring Formation.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Pierce Canyon 33 Federal #1H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This will be drilled at a legal location being 350' FSL & 350' FEL Section 33, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 11,000' to test the Bone Spring Formation.

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<u>Poker Lake Unit Pierce Canyon 16 Federal #1H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This will be drilled at a legal location being 330' FSL & 330' FEL Section 16, T25S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 12,786' to test the Bone Spring Formation.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Pierce Canyon 7 Federal #1H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This will be drilled at a legal location being 350' FNL & 350' FWL Section 7, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 11,845' to test the Bone Spring Formation.

OFFSET OBLIGATIONS

Appropriate and adequate measures will be taken to prevent drainage of unitized substances from lands covered by the Poker Lake Unit Agreement or pursuant to applicable regulations.

MODIFICATIONS

In accordance with the terms and provisions of the Poker Lake Unit Agreement, this Plan of Development may be modified from time to time as a result of changing conditions.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Plan of Development became effective on January 1, 2010.
