Energen Resources Corporation has made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for relief in the following matter: Case No. 14424. Application of Energen Resources Corporation for Compulsory Pooling, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Fruitland Coal formation (Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool) underlying irregular Section 9, Township 32 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, forming a 273.12 acre ± spacing and proration unit to be dedicated to the Carracas 9-B Well No. 16-H. Pursuant to the provisions of Order No. R-13119, the well will be directionally drilled from a surface location 2043 feet from the South line and 220 feet from the West line in Section 9, penetrating the Fruitland Coal formation at a point 1,400 feet from the South line and 760 feet from the West line of Section 9, with a standard bottom hole location 1,400 feet from the South line and 760 feet from the East line of Section 9, Township 32 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. It is believed that the individual(s) named above may have held title to certain mineral interests in the above Section 9. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, des-

ignation of applicant as operator and a charge for risk involved in drilling the well. The lands that are the subject of the application are located approximately 6 miles south of Arboles, Colorado. This application will be set for hearing before a Division Examiner at 8:15 a.m. on February 4, 2010 at the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division, 1220 South St. Francis Dr. Santa Fe, New Mexico. Any owner of an interest that may be affected may appear and present testimony.
