I, Corey Mitchell, being first duly sworn on oath, states as follows:

1. My name is Corey Mitchell. I reside in Midland, Texas. I am the Landman employed by Mewbourne Oil Company (“Mewbourne”) who is familiar with the status of the lands in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 5, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. I am a Landman with over 2 1/2 years experience in the Permian Basin. I received my Petroleum Land Management degree from Texas Tech University in 2007.

2. Mewbourne seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Yeso formation in all formations and pools in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 5, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

3. Mewbourne owns working interest in the NE/4 SW/4 of said Section 5 and proposes to dedicate the above-referenced spacing and proration unit to its West Draw “5” K Well No. 1 to be drilled as a wildcat oil well at a standard location 1650 feet from the South Line and 2310 feet from the West Line (Unit K) of said Section 5 to a depth sufficient to evaluate all formations from the surface through the Yeso formation. **Attachment A** is a plat of the subject lands showing the proposed spacing unit and the well location.

4. The proposed spacing unit consists of seven (7) Leases. **Attachment B** lists the nature and percentage of the ownership interests in the subject spacing unit.

5. This application has been instituted solely to pool the interests of a working interest owner who do not oppose the application.

6. Mewbourne has made a good faith effort to locate and gain the voluntary participation of all working interest owners in the proposed spacing unit.

A. In an attempt to locate the working interest owners, Mewbourne examined the Eddy County records, telephone directories and internet directories.

B. Notice of this application has been provided to all interest owners subject to pooling unless there whereabouts cannot be determined and notice in these cases has been provided by publication in accordance with Division Rules.

C. None of these owners has voluntarily committed their interest to the proposed well.

D. A copy of the well proposal letter and relevant correspondence is included as **Attachment C.**

7. Mewbourne requests that this interest owners be pooled and Mewbourne Oil Company be designated operator of the wells and the spacing unit.

8. Mewbourne proposes overhead charges (combined fixed rates) of \$4,000 per month while drilling and \$400 per month while producing. These rates are fair and reasonable, and are in line with rates charged by other operators in this area for wells of this depth. Applicant also requests that the order contain a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure.

9. **Attachment D** is a copy of the authorization for the expenditure (AFE) for the well which estimates costs to casing point to be \$342,100 and a completed cost of \$752,500.

10. Mewbourne plans to drill the West Draw "5" K Well No. 1 by May 1, 2010.

11. **Attachment E** consists of copies of the letters sent to those interest owners Mewbourne seeks to pool and an affidavit of publication given pursuant to Division rules.



Mewbourne Oil Company (Mewbourne) is interested in acquiring a Term Assignment covering your interest in the S/2SE/4NW/4, SW/4NW/4, SW/4NE/4 and S/2 of the captioned Section 5 and in the N/2 of the captioned Section 8, as to depths from the surface to 4,500' beneath the surface, all in T20S, R25E, Eddy County, New Mexico. Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne") as Operator proposes to form the captioned working interest unit ("WIU") to comprise the captioned land, excluding existing wellbores, associated equipment and associated production and the 40 acres oil proration units around existing wellbores, containing 1040.60 acres, more or less covering depths from the surface to 4,500 feet beneath the surface. The primary target formation for the proposed unit is the Yeso formation. This letter is to advise you that Mewbourne Oil Company has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking the force pooling of all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Yeso formation in all formations and pools in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 5, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant proposes to dedicate the pooled units to its West Draw "5" K Well No. 1. to be drilled as a wildcat oil well at a standard location 1650 feet from the South Line and 2310 feet from the West Line (Unit K) of said Section 5.

This application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner at 8:15 AM on March 18, 2010. The hearing will be held in Porter Hall in the Oil Conservation Division's Santa Fe Offices located at 1220 South Saint Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. 
