STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT

Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in all formations from the surface to the base of the Yeso in in all formations and pools in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 7, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M to be dedicated to applicant's West Draw "7" B Well No. 1 to be drilled as a wildcat oil well at a standard location 330 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the East line (Unit B) of said Section 7. Also to be considered will

be the cost of drilling and completing said well, the allocation of the cost thereof, actual operating costs and charges for supervision, the designation of Mewbourne Oil Company as operator of the well, and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 3 miles Northwest of Lakewood, New Mexico.


