19 Resources, Inc., for special pool rules or, in the

7	That was called by the Director. So if you see November
8	the 6th anywhere on the docket today, please change that to
9	November 7th.
10	Okay, let's see. Second page, Application of
11	Mewbourne Oil Company for an unorthodox oil well location,
12	Lea County, that's Case 13,172, this case will be continued
13	to the November 7th docket.
14	Okay, let's go to page 3. Case 13,156, this is
15	Chi Energy, Inc., for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New
16	Mexico. This case will be dismissed.
17	Case 13,173, Application of Merrion Oil and Gas
18	Corporation for an unorthodox infill coal gas well
19	location, San Juan County, New Mexico. This case will be
20	dismissed. This case should never have showed up on
21	today's docket. It was withdrawn prior to it getting on
22	the docket due to lack of communication on my part with the
23	appropriate people. It got on the docket and I apologize
24	for that. It was an administrative application that was
25	going to be set for hearing but was withdrawn prior to

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1	that. Again, I apologize. 13,173 will be dismissed.
2	Let's see, down to 13,175, this is the
3	Application of Permian Resources, Inc., for a nonstandard
4	spacing and proration unit and an unorthodox well location,
5	Lea County. This case will be continued to December the

8	Application of EOG Resources, Inc., for compulsory pooling
9	and a nonstandard gas spacing unit, Lea County, New Mexico.

12	Arrington Oil and Gas, Inc., for a waterflood project and
13	an enhanced oil recovery, Lea County, New Mexico. This
14	case is dismissed.
15	Down at the bottom of the page, 13,142, this is
16	the Application of the OCD for an order requiring Maralo,
17	L.L.C., to remediate hydrocarbon contamination and an
18	abandoned well and battery site, Lea County, New Mexico.
19	This case is continued to November the 20th.
20	Are there any other continuances or dismissals at
21	this time?
22	MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, on the first page
23	EXAMINER STOGNER: Okay.
24	MR. BRUCE: at the bottom, 13,139, the Gruy
25	Petroleum Management Company case, I would ask that that be

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continued to November 20th. 1 EXAMINER STOGNER: Continued to November 20th. 2 Just as a reminder, before I do, we're having a 3 lot of continuances and dismissals, and it has appeared 4 over the last few months that the dockets in some cases are 5 small and then they turn large some other times, so we may 6 mr. 7 need to adjust at a later date. 13134 At this time, though, Case 13,129, will be 8 continued to the November 20th docket. 9 MR.
