TORCH ENERGY SERVICES, INC. ("Torch")(OGRID 241401), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for an order approving its San Juan Mesa 4-30 Exploratory Unit and in support of this application states:

1. The proposed Unit Area consists of 9160 acres, more or less, of State of New Mexico and Fee lands, situated in Roosevelt County, New Mexico. The horizontal limits of said unit are described as follows:

2. The Unit Agreement has been approved by a sufficient percentage of the interest owners within the proposed Unit Area to provide effective control of unit operations.

3. The Applicant, Torch Energy Services, Inc., is designated as Unit Operator in said Unit Agreement and all oil and gas in all formations are unitized.

4. The unit boundaries are consistent and substantially supported by the geological limits of the unitized formations.

5. Said Unit Agreement and the unitized operation and management of the Unit Area will be in the interest of conservation and the prevention of waste, and it will protect the correlative rights of all parties concerned.

WHEREFORE, Torch Energy Services, Inc. requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on June 24, 2010, that notice be given as required by law and the rules of the Division, and that the San Juan Mesa 4-30 Exploratory Unit be approved.
