- 1 EXAMINER BROOKS: At this time, we will
- 2 call Case Number 14489, application of Cimarex Energy
- 3 Company for a nonstandard oil spacing and proration unit
- 4 and compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Call for
- 5 appearances.
- 6 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of
- 7 Santa Fe, representing the applicant. I am submitting
- 8 this by affidavit.
- 9 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay.
- 10 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, the first
- 11 exhibit is the affidavit of Todd Meador, the landman for
- 12 Cimarex. In this case, the applicant seeks the approval
- of a 160-acre nonstandard unit comprised of the west
- 14 half/west half of Section 24 in 19 South, 32 East.
- This well unit will be dedicated to the East
- 16 Lusk 24 Fed. Com. Well Number 1, which is a horizontal
- 17 well to be drilled commencing in the northwest
- 18 quarter/northwest quarter and southward to a location in
- 19 the southwest quarter/southwest quarter. Again, we are
- 20 only seeking to pool the Bone Spring formation in the
- 21 nonstandard unit.
- 22 On page 2, Mr. Examiner, let me point out that
- 23 there were a number of parties listed. However, late
- 24 yesterday afternoon, a number of parties signed JOAs or
- 25 agreed to assign their interest. So at this point, the

- only party being pooled is TriTex Energy A, LP. All
- 2 other parties have voluntarily joined in the well.
- 3 The applicant requests a 200 percent risk
- 4 charge for the well. In this case they request overhead
- 5 rates of 6,500 per month for a drilling well and \$650 per
- 6 month for a producing well. And I would point out, in
- 7 case you ask, Mr. Examiner, this well was permitted in
- 8 the name of Cimarex Energy Company itself, so that will
- 9 be the operator of the well.
- 10 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay. Cimarex Energy
- 11 Company will be the operator.
- MR. BRUCE: The offset operators or
- 13 lessees are also identified. And Attachment A is simply
- 14 a land plat identifying the acreage being pooled. And
- 15 Exhibit B is the well proposal to TriTex. And Exhibit C
- is the AFE for the well, with a dry-hole cost of about
- 17 1.8 and a completed well cost just under \$3.8 million for
- 18 the well.
- 19 Exhibit 2 is the affidavit of Lee Catalano,
- 20 the landman for Cimarex. And attached are a structure
- 21 map and a cross-section and a directional drilling plan
- 22 for the well.
- 23 Cimarex believes that each quarter/quarter
- 24 section will be productive and that the greater reservoir
- 25 lengths will increase the chances of a successful

1	economic completion.
2	Exhibit 3 is the affidavit of notice to the
3	party being pooled. And TriTex Energy A, LP, did receive
4	actual notice. And Exhibit 4 is the affidavit of notice
5	to the offsets and the offset operators. Also, all these
6	operators or working interest owners also received actual
7	notice.
8	And with that, I move the admission of
9	Exhibits 1 through 4.
10	EXAMINER BROOKS: 1 through 4 are
11	admitted.
