

The Mewbourne Oil Company has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order approving an 80-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Glorieta Yeso formation comprised of the W2S/4 of Section 15, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Glorieta Yeso formation underlying the non-standard spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools or formations developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Limousine 15 ML Well No. 1, a horizontal well with a surface location 245 feet from the north line and 370 feet from the west line of adjoining Section 22 and a terminus 2310 feet from the south line and 370 feet from the west line of Section 15. The producing interval of the well will be orthodox, although the well will penetrate the top of the Glorieta Yeso formation at an unorthodox location in the SW 1/4 of Section 15. Applicant also seeks approval of the unorthodox location. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well and a 20% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, May 12, 2011, at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date. The attorney for applicant is James Bruce, P.O. Box 1056, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504. The unit is located approximately 3 1/2 miles southwest of Seven Rivers, New Mexico.
