

APPLICATION

Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LLC applies for an exception to the Special Rules and Regulations of the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Associated Pool (the "Pool"), to allow two wells to be completed in the same quarter section, and for simultaneous dedication, and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant is the operator of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 36, Township 21 South, Range 23 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.

2. Special rules and regulations for the Pool were adopted by Division Order No. R-9922, as amended, requiring, among other things, (a) 320 acre spacing, and (b) wells to be located no closer than 660 feet to the outer boundary of a proration unit nor closer than 330 feet to a quarter-quarter section line.

3. Division Order No. R-9922-E also provides that only one well shall be allowed per quarter section in certain acreage in the Pool adjoining the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, including the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 36.

4. The W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 36 is currently dedicated to the Lowe State Gas Com Well No. 5, located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36.

5. Applicant proposes to drill its Lowe State Gas Com Well No. 6, at an orthodox location in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, on the

same quarter section as the Lowe State Gas Com Well No. 5. Applicant further seeks to simultaneously dedicate the Lowe State Gas Com Well Nos. 5 and 6 to the W½ of Section 36.


6. Applicant requests that the Lowe State Gas Com Well Nos. 5 and 6 be allowed to produce concurrently.

7. Offset operators have waived objection to this application.

8. The granting of this application is in the interests of conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the relief requested above be granted.

PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT

Case 13202 : Application of Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LLC for an exception to the Special Rules and Regulations of the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Associated Pool, and for simultaneous dedication, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an exception to the Special Rules and Regulations of the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Associated Pool to allow both its existing Lowe State Gas Com Well No. 5 and its proposed Lowe State Gas Com Well No. 6 to be located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, Township 21 South, Range 23 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks approval of the simultaneous dedication of both wells to a standard well unit comprised of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 36, and that the wells be allowed to produce concurrently. The well unit is located approximately 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles west of Carlsbad, New Mexico.
