NOW, on this 21st day of December, 1994, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,


FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, Santa Fe Energy Operating Partners, L. P., seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Undesignated South Corbin-Wolfcamp Pool underlying the W/2 NE/4 of Section 14, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to form a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.
- (3) Prior to the hearing, the applicant requested this matter be dismissed.
- (4) Dismissal of this case should therefore be granted.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:
