Dear David:

Pursuant to our recent telephone conversation, I am requesting an opportunity to present evidence on the January 5, 1995 hearing docket to support a drilling location for the Angell #1 Wolfcamp test in the East Denton Field at approximately 550' FNL and 2600' FEL of Section 4, T-15-S R-38-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The location is the optimum structural point to recover the maximum possible reserves from the Wolfcamp formation based on a 3-D seismic interpretation. Harvard Petroleum Corporation is the lessee of record of all of Section 4 and thus there are no affected parties. As a petroleum engineer and the person most familiar with the facts surrounding this request, I anticipate being the only person to testify. Since there are no affected parties, I do not plan to be represented by legal counsel.
