
MARBOB ENERGY CORPORATION, through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for an order approving an unorthodox well location, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant is the operator of the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 33, Township 13 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Chaves County, New Mexico on which it proposes to drill its White Fang Federal No. 1 Well as a wildcat well in the Devonian formation, at a location of 1353 feet from the North line and 1914 feet from the West line in Unit F of said Section 33.
2. Applicant seeks an exception to Division's well location requirements to permit the drilling of said well in the Devonian formation at the above-described location.
3. A standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprised of the SE/4 NW/4 of said Section 33 should be dedicated to the well.
4. Approval of this application will afford Applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in then Devonian formation and will otherwise be in the best interest of the conservation, the protection of correlative rights and the prevention of waste.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before a duly appointed Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on April 6, 1995 that notice be given as required by law, the Division enter its order granting this application and providing such other relief as is proper.
