If you desire to deal with the data exchange and to set up a timetable for this case I suggest the following:

"Reference is made to our "conference call" this morning, Tuesday, April 18, 1995, whereby we discussed Mr. Kellahin's letter dated April 14, 1995 requesting the production of data from Yates and the continuance of both cases to the hearing scheduled for June 1, 1995. Thereafter, I conducted an initial review of Nearburg's concern about the two existing salt water disposal wells in the North Dagger Draw-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool in Sections 21 and 22 Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico (approved by Division Order Nos. SWD-336 and R-7637) and the potential issues they may create in this matter. I conclude that the two SWD wells and the disposal of that produced water are relevant to these pooling cases and that a postponement until June 1, 1995 is in order.

In addition, the parties are directed to voluntarily exchange data and if there is a dispute over the data requested, produced or to be exchanged then either party may return to the Division for decisions on that topic.

I hope that both parties will utilize this time to exchange data and to work out a reasonable solution. If not, then these SWD wells and the disposed water can be discussed at length as it relates to these pooling cases.

The parties are directed to report to the Division on the status of their discussions on or before May 15, 1995.

Nearburg's request for continuance of both Case Nos 11263 and 11265 until June 1, 1995 is hereby approved."


